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Cycle infrastructure review

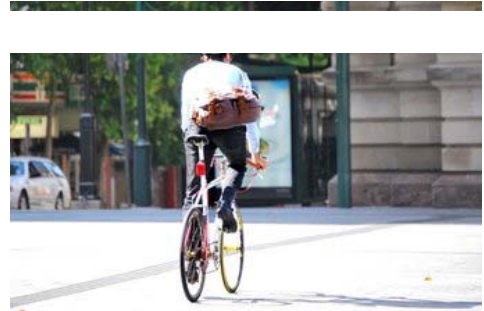

Minister Troy Buswell today announced recommendations to improve Perth's cycling infrastructure in the first comprehensive review in more than a decade.
